International Articulation Agreements

Oklahoma Christian University (OC) has articulation agreements with three international universities to assist students in China, Japan, and Korea in completing coursework and degrees in their home countries and in the United States. These agreements are with Xi'an Polytechnic University (XPU) in China, Ibaraki Christian University (IC) in Japan, and Korea Christian University in Korea (KCU).

Xi'an Polytechnic University (XPU)
XPU students can participate in articulation agreements with OC for both undergraduate and graduate programs of study. The undergraduate agreement allows transfer course equivalencies for the following classes:

Ibaraki Christian University (IC)

OC also has an articulation agreement with IC, which is a dual-degree program that allows students to obtain a bachelor degree from IC and a bachelor degree from OC. IC students transfer credits to OC and then complete the rest of their degree requirements to earn a bachelor degree from the institution. Then they return to IC, transfer OC credits to the institution, and earn a second bachelor degree from IC.

The details of transfer requirements and equivalencies at OC are as follows:

At IC, one unit (1) consists of 15 meetings of instruction. Each class meets once a week and instructional durations are 90 minutes per class. Therefore, one unit at IC is equal to 1.5 credits at OC. The above IC courses are considered equal to 36 credits at OC.

IC students participating in the dual degree program must complete a mathematics course at OC. They will be exempt from this requirement if they successfully pass a challenge test for an appropriate mathematics subjects at OC.

IC students will also have to complete 8 hours of Bible at OC. (This is a significant decrease from the 16 hours that first time students are required to take.) One at these classes must include Capstone: Christ and His World, which is worth 3 credits. Students should take this class during their last semester at OC.

Korea Christian University (KCU)

As part of their articulation agreement with Korea Christian University, OC accepts a maximum of 12 students into a 2+2 academic program. KCU students complete the first two years of their academic program on the KCU campus. Students then transfer to the OC campus to complete their degrees in select programs. This dual-degree program allows students to obtain a bachelor degree from KCU and a degree from OC. KCU students transfer credits to OC and then complete the rest of their degree requirements to earn a bachelor degree from the institution. Then they return to KCU, transfer OC credits to the institution, and each a second bachelor degree from KCU.

This 2+2 agreement follows the same transfer rules as those for students with associate or baccalaureate degrees from another institution. Page 22 of the 2015-16 Undergraduate Academic Catalog states, "If you transfer to OC with an associate degree designed to provide the core curriculum background for a baccalaureate degree, OC will consider the hours taken before coming to OC when determining your core curriculum requirements. The associate degree program must include at least 30 hours in courses typically required for the core curriculum with at least one course in the following seven categories: communication, math, American citizenship, behavioral/social science, literature/fine arts, science, and global civilization. If you have fulfilled at least five of these categories prior to coming to OC, you will be able to complete courses on campus to fulfill up to two deficient areas in the seven categories. You will also be required to complete the following at OC: 6-8 hours of Bible, to include BIBL-4523: Capstone: Christ and His World" (emphasis added).
